Eligibility requirements for TC:



<\$10M in sales per year



<40,000 square feet for one location



<\$10M total property value



<\$1M in payroll



<35% use of subcontractors

A minimum of \$10,000 Business Personal Property or Building coverage is required for BOP and Target Contractor products.

A Liability-only option is available for quoting on a Commercial Package product for Target Contractor classes. Options to include Property, Inland Marine, Crime, Cyber Security, and EPLI are available when quoting on a Commercial Package product.

Air conditioning systems or equipment – dealers or distributors, installation, servicing, or repair

Appliances and accessories – installation, servicing, or repair (commercial or household)

Carpentry – interior

Carpet, rug, furniture, or upholstery cleaning – shop or on customers' premises

Ceiling or wall installation – metal

Communication equipment installation – industrial or commercial

*Concrete construction

*Conduit construction for cables or wires

*Driveway, parking area, or sidewalk – paving or repaving

Drywall or wallboard installation (excluding work comp)

Electrical wiring within buildings
